Alert level 3 – Orange

Kwe everyone,


The COVID-19 multidisciplinary emergency committee wishes to inform the population that since the start of the pandemic there have been only five cases of COVID-19 in the community, of which four have fully recovered. This situation reflects the will of the population to comply with health measures and the committee wishes to thank everyone for their efforts. Rest assured that the committee is closely monitoring the evolution of the current pandemic situation with the various government stakeholders, including the Direction de la santé publique du Québec.

It is also important to inform you that the territory of Wendake is currently in a health region of Quebec with an **alert level 3 - Orange level**.

Here are the measures implemented for alert level 3 – Orange level:

Interim measures in force

Private gatherings inside or outside	Maximum of 6 people OR 2 families (therefore 2 families accepted even if more than 6 people)
Activities organized in public places	Maximum of 25 people inside and outside (rented rooms, places of worship, festive events, weddings, professional or school celebrations, BBQs, picnics, etc.)
Restaurants	Maximum of 6 people per table Alcohol sales end at 11 pm End of alcohol consumption at midnight
Shops	1 person per household recommended Delivery services and help from selected relatives for people with high risk of complications
Interregional travel	Not recommended



We would like to remind you of the importance of following the following guidelines:

- Wash your hands often with warm running water and soap for at least 20 seconds;
- Comply with the two-metre social distancing rule;
- Wearing a mask is compulsory in closed public places.

Rest assured that strict measures have been put in place at the Centre de Santé Marie-Paule-Sioui-Vincent and the Résidence Marcel-Sioui in order to protect the health of the clientele as well as the staff who work there. For more information regarding our services, please call 418-842-6255.
