## PUBLIC NOTICE CONCERNING VACCINATION

Kwe everyone,

A first phase in the vaccination rollout took place on January 11<sup>th</sup> at the Résidence Marcel-Siouï (seniors' residence). All our residents are now vaccinated. To achieve this, we were able to rely on the excellent cooperation of the team of the Centre intégré universitaire de santé et de services sociaux de la Capitale-Nationale (CIUSSSCN). As part of this vaccination, the employees and physicians who work with this clientele were vaccinated.

Our goal now is to launch the vaccination campaign to immunize our population. We hope that, by the end of spring 2021, all members of the Huron-Wendat Nation and residents of the community will be vaccinated. Some unforeseeable factors may arise but rest assured that we are working hard to ensure the success of this vaccination operation.

We do not yet know exactly when the vaccination campaign will launch and some of the general points surrounding this process still require clarification. As soon as we have more information, you can be certain that we will get back to you with the details.

The first step in preparing for the vaccination campaign is to take a census of the number of people wishing to be vaccinated. We need to determine the number of vaccine doses needed very quickly to maximize the coordination of operations. An online survey has been launched so that you can express your interest. A team from the Marie-Paule-Siouï-Vincent Health Centre will also contact you to confirm your desire to be vaccinated.

The information will be collected in complete confidentiality. Given the very tight deadlines with which we must deal, you may receive this notice after receiving a call. Be aware that the team will take the time to verbally inform you of the ongoing procedure. The survey must be completed before **February 18<sup>th</sup>**.
